FAFSA Income Changes

If significant changes in income during 2022, 2023, or 2024 result in a lower family income than reported on your FAFSA, you may qualify for a special income review.

Major changes may include:

- Divorce or separation of parents or from spouse;
- Death of a major wage earner;
- Loss or reduction of personal or family income by at least 25%

Having your social security number is essential for these aid programs:


Calculating Your Costs

Is there an easy way to figure out how much it costs to attend USF?

- Yes, use our Cost Calculator.
 It will estimate your bill before payments are due.
- After you receive your financial aid award letter, go to www.usf.edu/financial-aid
- Click on the "Cost Calculator" link

Do I have to do all the math?

 Nope! Just enter all your costs and let the calculator do the rest! Use our Cost Calculator to estimate costs before payments are due.







Review Financial Aid Offer

- Check your USF email in mid-April!
- Your aid offer will list estimates of USF costs for two semesters
- This is not your bill!
- Student bills become available from Student Accounting Services (SAS) in late July/early August in OASIS







Florida Bright Futures Scholarships



- Review all correspondence on the Bright Futures website! You will not receive emails or letters!
- You must be classified as a Florida resident by the Office of Admissions to receive Florida Bright Futures
- Funds are available during the Summer 2024 semester
- Log into your Bright Futures account and make sure you have USF listed as your school!

Florida Pre-Paid




- Tuition plan covers the basic cost of classes
- Local fee plan covers the state required fees
- Differential tuition fee plan covers additional tuition fees charged by state universities
- Dormitory plan covers the cost of a standard, double-occupancy room at a Florida university
 - There are additional fees included in the tuition and fees which the Pre-Paid tuition plan does not cover. Review your contract for details...

Florida Bright Futures and **Pre-Paid**

- You will receive the full Bright Futures and Pre-Paid payments even if there are other types of aid that pay tuition and fees
- Bright Futures funds are paid after the end of the first week of classes
- Pre-Paid payments are made after the third week of classes
- Any remaining funds are refunded to the student or used to pay other charges on the student's USF bill







Bright Futures and Pre-Paid – Here's the Math!

• Tuition & fees (15 credit hours) \$3,204.85

On-campus housing (Village Double) \$4,963.00

• Meal Plan (Open Access) \$2,545.00

Total Due Before Aid is Applied:

\$10,712.85

• Bright Futures (Academic Scholars)

\$3,130.35

• Florida Pre-Paid Payment (Tuition plan) \$2,476.40

Total Payment Made:

\$5,606.75

\$10,712.85 minus \$5,606.75 = \$5,106.10 (paid from other sources of financial aid or out of pocket)




How Does Financial Aid Pay Your Bill?

- All financial aid programs (except Florida Pre-Paid) are paid at the end of the first week
 of classes each semester
- The bill is paid in the following order
 - 1. Tuition and Fees
 - 2. Housing (if living on campus)
 - 3. Meal Plan (if living on campus)
 - 4. Bookstore (if you are eligible to use the Bookstore Advance Purchase Program)
- If there is enough financial aid to pay the bill in full and there are excess funds, you will receive a refund by electronic deposit (if you have subscribed to e-Deposit in OASIS) or a paper check during the second week of classes



Student Reminders

- THE FAFSA IS FREE! Never pay anyone to complete the form for you
- PAY ATTENTION TO REQUIREMENTS Monitor OASIS and your USF email often
- **EVERYONE QUALIFIES FOR SOMETHING** Even if your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) makes you ineligible for grants, you can still receive unsubsidized loans
- SUBMIT A NEW FAFSA EVERY OCTOBER





Parent Reminders

- Students are responsible for all of their financial aid applications and requirements (we will send you periodic email reminders in case your student forgets)
- · We can only share limited information about your student's financial aid if:
- You are listed as the parent on the FAFSA
- Your student has completed the Online Privacy Release for Dependent Students in OASIS;
 this is an additional release not covered by FERPA!
- All correspondence is sent to the student's USF email and local mailing addresses in OASIS.
 Remind them to check it regularly!





Things to Remember:

- Office of Admissions (SVC 1036) determines residency for tuition purposes prior to classes beginning, awards scholarships upon admission
- Office of the Registrar (SVC 1034) updates residency for tuition purposes once student is actively attending classes
- Office of Financial Aid (SVC 1102) awards student aid and disburses to student account; enforces USF admissions scholarship terms and conditions
- Student Accounting Services (SVC 1039) applying aid to the student's USF bill,
 Florida Pre-Paid, third-party payments, places/releases holds on the student account,
 processes refunds and checks






