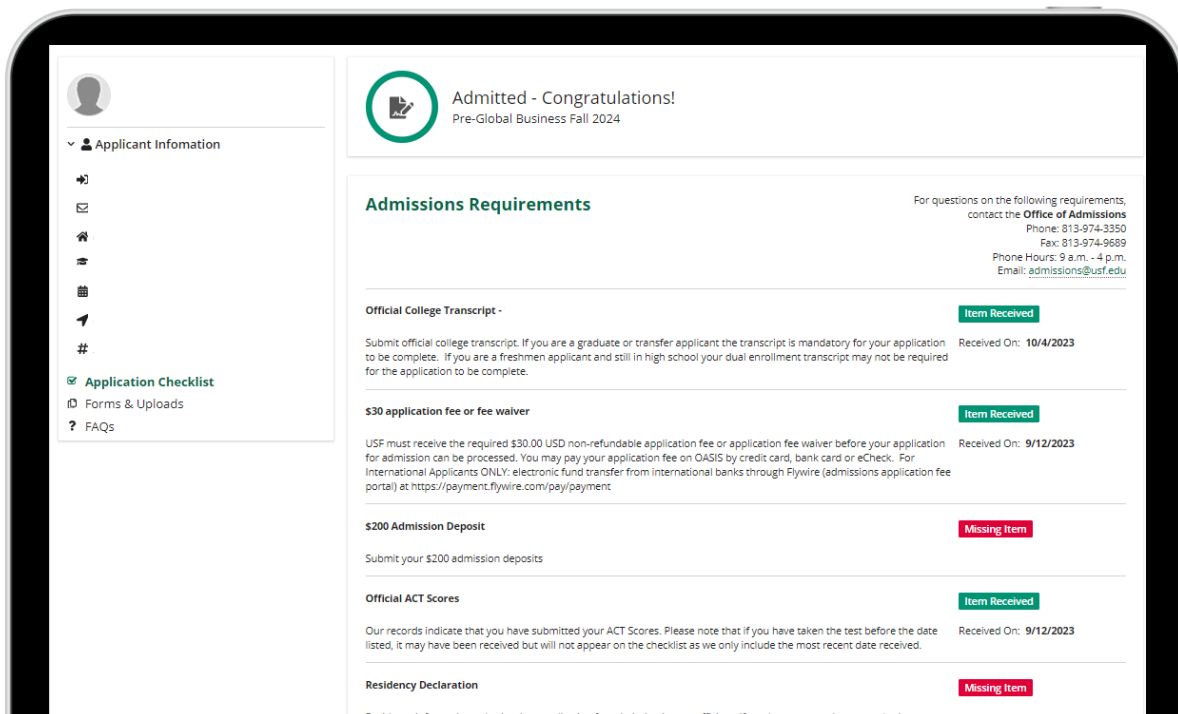

Using USF's Admissions Portals

<p>Centralized USF intranet for email, calendars and other login-required functions for students.</p> <p>Use When:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Accessing USF email• Accessing OASIS• Accessing Canvas	<p>Intranet for USF applicants to use update forms and check on required documents.</p> <p>Use When:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Submitting a form• Checking on required admissions documents• Looking for general admissions status	<p>Portal for admitted students to check on all onboarding requirements for USF.</p> <p>Use When:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Looking at required to-dos for enrollment• Ensuring you've completed tasks• Getting ahead of requested documents	<p>Platform for students to officially update their records and access official content like final grades.</p> <p>Use When:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Accepting your USF scholarship• Looking for financial aid award package• Paying admission deposit



Using the Applicant Portal



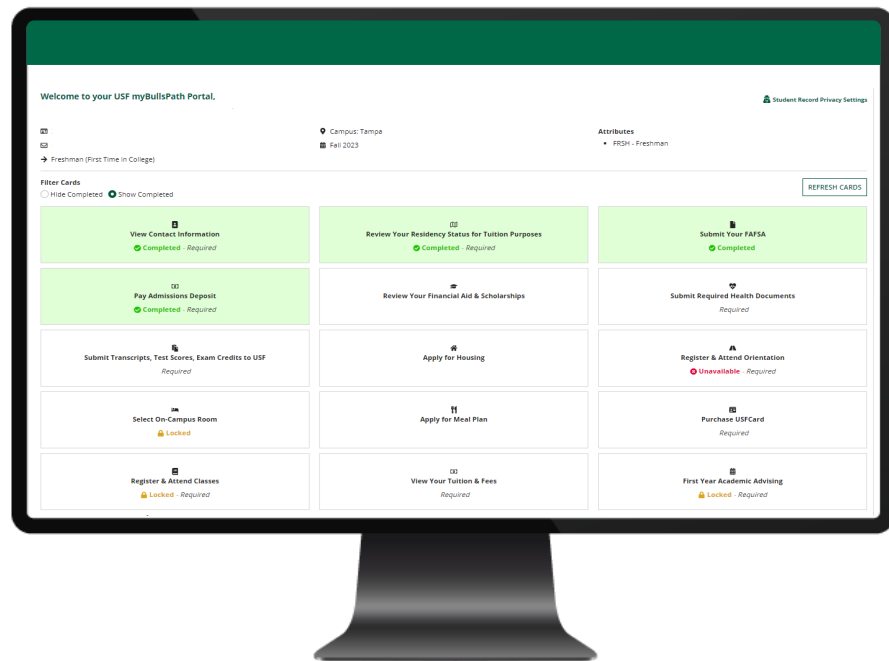


Using myBullsPath Portal

- Use your NetID and password to login.
- You should see a series of “cards” that represent tasks you need to complete for enrollment.
 - **Green** means you’ve completed the task.
 - **Red** means you haven’t completed the task.
 - **Yellow** means the task is in progress.
 - **Gray** means you will need to complete this task in the future, but not now.

Deposit Deadline: May 1

Enrollment Requirement:

Submit nonrefundable \$200 admission deposit

- Deposit will be applied toward your first semester's tuition at USF.

- There is a required \$35 Orientation fee for student Orientation.
- Families can attend the optional Family/Guest Orientation for an additional fee.

On-Campus Housing

Applications Now Open

Steps to apply for housing:

1. Complete the housing application in the housing portal
2. Submit the nonrefundable \$50 housing application fee
3. Pay your \$200 nonrefundable admission deposit
4. Reserve and pay for your Orientation session (\$35)
5. Select your room

Medical History Form

Deposit Deadline: May 1

Enrollment Requirement:
Submit Medical History Form

- You can find via admissions.usf.edu/myBullsPath on the Submit Required Health Documents card.
- You must complete this prior to course registration. Failure to submit on time will delay course registration.
- You will typically need sign-off from your doctor, so leave enough time to complete!



Financial Aid/Scholarships

FAFSA: What to Expect

- USF will start to receive FAFSA information in mid-March from the Department of Education.
- Incoming freshmen will start to receive financial aid packages in mid-April.
- Students will be informed via email from the USF Office of Financial Aid once awarded.

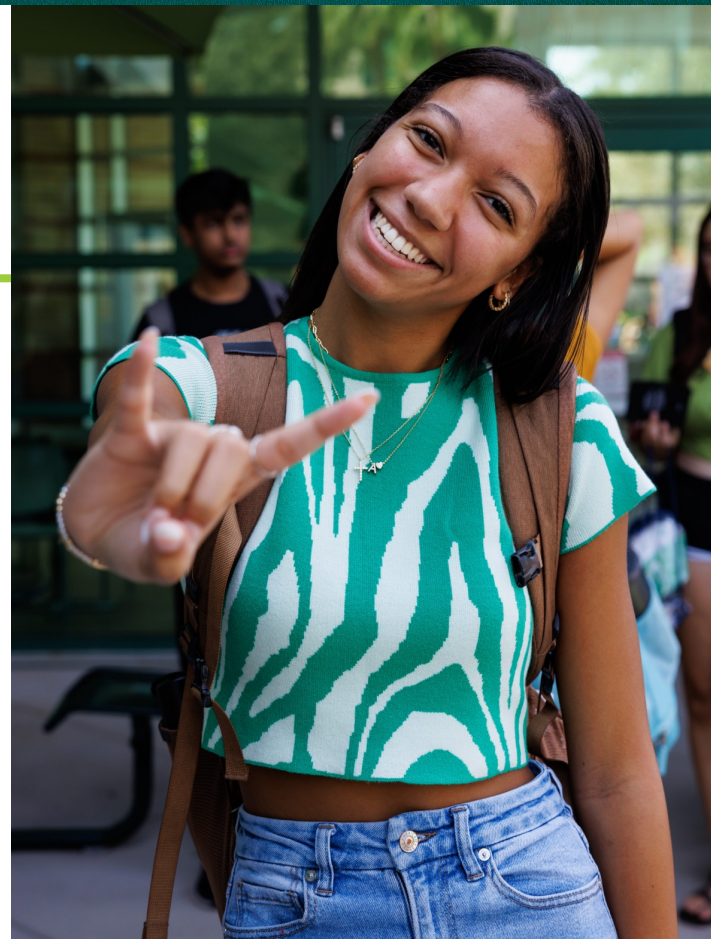


Final High School Transcript

Submit After Graduation

Enrollment Requirement: Submit Final High School Transcript

- Your final high school transcript will need to include your graduation date and all courses be listed as completed.
- You must complete this prior to course registration. Failure to submit on time will delay course registration and disbursement of financial aid and FL Bright Futures.
- You will typically work with your high school guidance counselor to obtain and send your transcripts.
