myBullsPath PORTAL



The myBullsPath portal is a one-stop shop student onboarding portal that allows you to complete all of your necessary tasks all in one place. To access this portal, please visit admissions.usf.edu/myBullsPath and log in with your USF NetID and password. Here you will see a series of "cards." Each card represents a task or series of tasks that you need to complete in order to begin courses at USF. They are color coded so you know which to pay attention to

- . Green means you've completed the task congrats!
- . Red means you need to complete the task
- Yellow means the task is in progress
- Gray means you will need to complete the task in the future, but not now.

Be sure you have take care of all the "cards" you can before your orientation session. This will prevent any possible delays in your journey.






Using myBullsPath Portal

- · Use your NetID and password to login.
- You should see a series of "cards" that represent tasks you need to complete for enrollment.
 - Green means you've completed the task.
 - Red means you haven't completed the task.
 - · Yellow means the task is in progress.
 - Gray means you will need to complete this task in the future, but not now.
- Complete enrollment steps like immunizations, housing room selection, advising and course registration, and ID card submission.
